

# Sportsman 18' Travel Trailer

### Accommodations

- ▶ (2) Queen sized beds
- ▶ Couch that converts to a full-sized bed
- ▶ Dining table with bench seats that converts to a twin bed
- ▶ Bathroom sink, toilet, and shower
- ▶ Air conditioning, electric heat, and propane
- ▶ City water connections, potable water tank, water heater, electric water pump
- ▶ City water connection hose (24' long, black/grey water drain hose)
- ▶ 30 amp extension cord (24' long) & 30 amp adapter
- ▶ Propane tank
- ▶ Deep cycle battery
- ▶ 2-burner stove, microwave, kitchen sink
- ▶ Digital TV antenna
- ▶ Refrigerator (electric or propane capable)
- ▶ Spare tire
- ▶ (2) rear scissor jack stabilizers
- ▶ Smoke, carbon monoxide, and propane detector

### Tow Vehicle Requirements:

- ▶ No less than 3,000 lbs. tow capacity (check your owner's manual)
- ▶ 2" ball (mounted 18-22" from ground to top of ball)
- ▶ 7 pin wire connection

### Other Considerations:

- ▶ Destination CANNOT exceed 300-mile radius of the Hampton Roads area
- ▶ NO PETS
- ▶ NO SMOKING
- ▶ Camper must be returned in the same condition it was issued; renter is responsible for damages outside of normal wear and tear.
- ▶ Camper must be returned clean or renter may opt to pay a \$50 cleaning fee.
- ▶ In the event of a flat tire, DO NOT use stabilizers to lift camper.
- ▶ We DO NOT check the amount of propane in our tanks when campers are issued or returned. If you plan to use propane during your trip, you may want to top off the existing tank, exchange it, or bring a spare.
- ▶ Ensure doors and foldout bunk ends are locked during travel.
- ▶ Ensure tongue jack and stabilizers are up before towing.



### Important Information:

You may pick up and return your camper between 8 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. **Camper are NOT to be left unattended in our parking lot if pick up or return window has been missed.** Upon pickup, an MWR staff member will inspect the camper with you and answer any questions. When returning the camper, please ensure both black and grey water valves are open and the drain cap is off prior to entering our facility compound. Drape the drain cap over one of the valves so it does not drag on the ground. Please allow 30 minutes for MWR staff to re-inspect and check camper.
